



General Rules for Angel Lagoon

- Emergencies: Call 911 immediately if medical attention is needed
- No emotional support or non-service animals allowed
- No glass containers
- Do not enter the lagoon if you have diarrhea
- Diaper changing must be done at least 6 feet away from the lagoon
- Access the lagoon only through the Welcome Center with proper ID or ticket
- Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult or guardian
- All bags, strollers, and personal items are subject to inspection
- The lagoon may close temporarily due to inclement weather
- Follow all posted and verbal staff instructions
- No running, pushing, rough play, or sitting on shoulders
- No soliciting or peddling
- No drugs or alcohol allowed
- Family-friendly attire must be worn at all times
- No sharp objects
- No open liquid containers for entry/exit
- No balls allowed
- No outside food or beverages allowed
- Staff reserves the right to eject guests not following rules
- Guests should consult their physician before engaging in activities
- Guests assume all risk by entering the facility
- Those with limitations that create a safety hazard should not participate
- Intoxicated or visibly impaired guests will be asked to leave with no refund
- We are not responsible for lost or stolen items
- Staff cannot hold valuables or bags
- Guests with open wounds or sores may not enter the lagoon

- Diaper-age children must wear swim diapers
- Tickets are non-refundable
- Turf, concrete, and sand may become hot—footwear is recommended
- Smoking, vaping, and e-cigarettes are not permitted
- Portions of the facility may close for maintenance, events, contamination, or weather
- No personal speakers permitted
- No loud, profane, lewd, aggressive, or abusive behavior
- No use of electronic devices in restrooms
- Facility may be under video surveillance
- Spanish-language rules available at Guest Services at the facility entrance
